

SUMMER CAMP: REQUIRED GEAR CHECKLIST

SHELTER

RSR provides a tent & a cot for each camper - tents are double occupancy

- 1 Pad for Sleeping Bag
- 2 Sleeping Bag & Small Pillow (a fleece liner bag is typically sufficient for Summer Camp)
- 3 Folding Chair or Stool
- 4 Hammock (camping style that you tie to trees)
- 5 Small Tarp (5'x7' or 6'x8')



FOOD / COOKING

All meals will be provided by RSR and eaten inside the Dining Hall - with the exception of Wednesday night when the Troop will provide Kentucky Fried Chicken, eaten picnic style outdoors

- 1 Healthy Snacks (put it in a container with your name on it - all snacks will be stored in the trailers)
- 2 Good Table Manners for inside the Dining Hall

PERSONAL ITEMS

Please be sure to put your name or initials on everything!

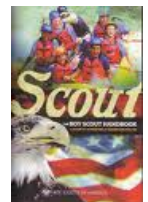
CLOTHING

- 1 Class A Uniform (must be worn on the way to Camp, and for each dinner)
- 2 4-5 Short Sleeve T-Shirts (including Class B T-shirts)
- 3 1-2 Long Sleeve T-Shirts or Light Weight Shirts
- 4 1 Sweatshirt or Fleece
- 5 2 Pair of Pants (zip-off pants work very well; avoid sweats and jeans)
- 6 3-4 Pair of Shorts (include Scout shorts if you own any)
- 7 1-2 Pair of Swimming Trunks
- 8 5-6 Pair of Underwear
- 9 6-7 Pair of Socks (include 1 pair of liner socks and 1 pair of wool socks)
- 10 2 Pair of Shoes or Boots (all sandals must have a closed toe)
- 11 1 Pair of Shower-type sandals
- 12 2 Handkerchiefs or Bandanas
- 13 1 Hat
- 14 1 Belt (Scout belt if you own one)
- 15 1 Pair of Work Gloves
- 16 1 Plastic Shirt Hanger (to hang up your Scout shirt each night)
- 17 1 Laundry Bag / Plastic Garbage bag (to hold your dirty laundry!)



ESSENTIALS

- 1 Day Pack or Waist Pack to Carry Water Bottles or Canteen for Hikes (2 liters minimum)
- 2 Rain Coat & Pants or Poncho
- 3 1-2 Water Bottles
- 4 Flashlight & Extra Batteries (Headlamps work well, and keep your hands free!)
- 5 Compass
- 6 Pocket Knife & Tot'n Chip Card
- 7 Personal First Aid Kit
- 8 Basic Toiletries (toothpaste/brush, soap, shampoo)
- 9 1-2 Towels (quick drying towels work great!)
- 10 Sunglasses (nothing fancy)
- 11 Sunscreen, Chapstick & Bug Spray
- 12 1 Wristwatch
- 13 Scout Handbook, Small Notebook, Pens & Pencils (put inside a gallon sized zip lock bag)
- 14 Merit Badge Prerequisites, Worksheets or Booklets
- 15 Spending Money - \$20-\$30 should be plenty
- 17 Positive Attitude & Outlook
