

JOINING BOY SCOUT TROOP 12

All options will require you to login OR create your my.scouting.org account.

Please do the following for:

SCOUT

- Register your scout on-line (see the url above). If you are coming from a Pack or Troop, choose “transfer”.
- Submit BSA Health and Medical form for parts A & B: <https://www.ocbsa.org/nmchub/attachment/bsa-health-form-abc/>. Note the scout and BOTH parents sign part B. Medical form part C is required for all events over 72 hours, high adventure events, and summer camp. Your child’s doctor must sign part C. Medical form part D is not necessary.

ADULT

ADULTS: MANDATORY BSA TRAINING:

- Go to <https://my.scouting.org>
- All Adults will need to receive BSA training in Youth Protection Training (YPT) before they can attend a campout. This is BSA policy. BSA YPT training is required to be completed each year.
- All Troop 12 Adults will also complete the online BSA training for a Troop Committee Member. The courses can be found at www.my.scouting.org.

ADULTS: MANDATORY CALIFORNIA TRAINING (AB 506, law requiring all volunteers with youth receive training and pass fingerprinting and DOJ background checks)

Under California law, all volunteers working with youth must complete California YPT training, which requires LiveScan fingerprinting.

1. REQUIRED STATE MANDATED REPORTER TRAINING

- All Employees, Registered Adult Volunteers, and Regular Volunteer positions identified as requiring training shall complete California-mandated training (2 hours) beginning January 1, 2022. The training is available at <https://mandatedreporterca.com/training/volunteers>

Regular Volunteer means a volunteer with the BSA who is 18 years of age or older and who has direct contact with, or supervision of, children more than 16 hours per month or 32 hours per year.

NOTE: This training is in addition to BSA Youth Protection Training.

2. STATE TRAINING COMPLETED

- Upload your state Mandated Reporter Training Certificate to your Council. Click on your Council's link below.
- Upload the **Background Check Consent Form (CLICK HERE to Download)** to your council. Click on your council's link below.

3. LIVE SCAN BACKGROUND CHECK

Option 1 (no paperwork)

- Complete the transaction by visiting <https://ApplicantServices.com/CaliforniaScouting> and click on button representing your Council.
- Each individual must pay online a fixed fingerprint rolling fee of \$26 and FBI background check fee (\$17)

Option 2 (must complete and bring Live Scan form)

- Fill out the Request for Live Scan Service form below.
- Find the Live Scan site nearest you <https://oag.ca.gov/fingerprints/locations>

- Bring the complete Request for Live Scan Service form to a service provider. It is critical that you use your Council's Live Scan form, as it includes your Council's routing information for your background check.
- Each individual must pay a fingerprint rolling fee (\$20 – \$40) and FBI background check fee (\$17) to the Live Scan service provider.

MEDICAL ABC FORM – MEDICAL A AND B DUE IMMEDIATELY – MEDICAL C REQUIRED FOR SUMMER CAMP

- Medical A, B and C Form. SEE LINK BELOW
- Complete and return AB immediately for Scout.
- Complete and return AB immediately for Adult.
- For summer camp or long term camping more than 72 hours, obtain physical exam from medical professional and complete and return Form C.

ITEMS TO PURCHASE

Class A Uniform: Your scout will need a tan collared button down shirt, scout pants (conversion zip-off pants that can be worn as shorts or pants), scout socks, scout belt, OC Council patch, neckerchief slide, and sash. A scout hat is optional but non-scouting hats are not permitted. All these items can be purchased at the Scout Shop. Boy Scout Handbook and Cover: Every scout needs the boy scout handbook.
